- 1 Attached the 2015 regulations- please note registration forms and indemnity needs to be completed and handed to me by Saturday morning sign on.
- 2 Sponsors-Our main sponsor once again this year is McGrady Insurance. Mandatory Sun-visor strips will be available from me if needed as are mandatory Rallysales.eu bumper stickers as per regulations.
- 3 Registration-All drivers must be registered by Saturday morning in able to take the start. Registration forms are attached at the end of the regulations. Co-driver registration is also encouraged, and there will be co-drivers winning trophy at the end of the season.
- 4 I will have a selection of race-wear with me for sale on Saturday- Citroen Racing, Peugeot Sport and Sabelt race-suits, Peltor 8860 helmet, and Ford and Citroen clothing- Sizes medium and small. If you are looking a change of gear come over and have a look, also some of it listed on the associate sponsor's website www.rallysales.eu
- 5 The cars and crew are going to be weighed before scrutiny so make sure that co-driver and his equipment is present to meet the 950kg minimum weight limit. Cars will be spot checked also during the event. MOT is also required.

The Table Plan is for tables of ten so please advise us of the names of your winners and guests and any other individuals or groups you would like to be seated alongside; we will try our best but this can't be guaranteed on every occasion.

Award Winners are allocated one non-transferable free place which they must book with their individual discipline coordinator who will also require a deposit of £ 20.00 to secure the place. Deposits will be refunded during the evening to attending award winners by the Co-ordinators

To allow time for us to plan the tables we need names, any seating requests and special requests of your attending Prize winners and other guests before **22 January 2015**.
