Championship Bulletin

The following change is to be made to the official regulations already published for the above Championship and in accordance with Motorsport UK general regulation D11.2 This change is to be implemented immediately.

Reason 1

To remove the requirement for drivers to marshal 1 round of either the sprint or hill climb championship in order to qualify for a Championship award. This has been agreed to relieve the pressure on clubs to accommodate extra marshals with covid 19 restrictions.

~~Revised Regulation: 1.6.3 (g) 1.6.3.(g) In order to qualify for a Championship Award, competitors are required to officiate/marshal at a minimum of EITHER one ANICC Millers Oils Hillclimb Championship round OR one ANICC SW Adair Tyres Sprint Championship round during the 2020 Championships. They must sign on as an official with the organising club and should inform by email the respective Championship Co-Ordinator within 14 days of having done so.~~
